Dear Parents,

Greetings to you!

This is a health and safety advisory, which is being issued to safeguard the health and safety of all our school students and staff members in light of the recent outbreak of Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) which has many positive cases now reported in various parts of India.

As per the approvals and directions of the state government and board, we will be reopening the school on **6th September 2021, Monday** by adopting all mandatory safety precautions and advisories of various local and central Government authorities.

We, as a responsible institution, are conscious of the need to take preventive and precautionary measures in the interest of our learners without creating undue panic. We also assure you of the highest standards of hygiene, awareness drive and precautionary measures being implemented at the school in the interest of the safety and well-being of the entire school community.

Along with all the control measures school will be adopting grade wise staggering methods to practise social distancing measures in school and buses details of which will be informed to you.

In the light of the seriousness of the issue, we request your support in the following;

- a) Ensure that you absolutely **DO NOT** send your child to school even in the case of a mild cough, sneezing, cold, fever or any flu-like symptoms. If any student does develop any of these symptoms, it is important that they stay away from school for **14** days after the symptoms subside.
- b) If a student or a member of their family has travelled and returned to any of, COVID-19 affected places, state or countries, inform details to the school. Please include a mandatory 14-day quarantine period **BEFORE THE STUDENTS RETURN TO SCHOOL**. As a responsible institution, we will support the child in all academic related aspects so that she/he does not miss out on important topics.
- c) Ensure your child comes to the school with a properly fitting facemask, a pair of disposable gloves and carry a small sanitiser bottle (above Grade 5) to use in case of

emergency. They should in addition carry some tissue paper in their bag for use in emergencies.

- d) Ensure good personal hygiene (clean uniform, nails, well groomed, oral and dental hygiene) of your child. Efforts to drive healthy eating habits and food that boost immunity will go a long way in ensuring long-term health benefits and reduce the chances of COVID19 infection in the current environment.
- e) Please take care to ensure the child does not use crowded vans / auto rickshaw or private transport which will expose them to the risk of infection. It may be prudent to personally drop / pick the child from the school.
- f) Avoid visiting school for any administrative purposes unless it is necessary. Prior to visiting please, contact the administration team and follow their instructions and guidelines on entry to the school.
- g) Instruct your wards to follow all rules, directions and guidelines of the school in the interest of safety and prevention of infection.
- h) Make sure you send us the health declaration form as a step to identify the individuals at risk.(form attached form as annexure B).
- i) Make sure you have downloaded AROGYA SETU APP in your mobiles before visiting the school.

We hope this global public health emergency will change over soon, and no member of our school community is affected. While we do not wish to alarm you, it is important that we take all precautionary measures, stay alert and stay healthy.

Further, we assure you that the learners shall be supported on the academic front in consultation with you in case they miss any classes because of preventive steps towards the effort to control COVID-19.

Key facts and information about COVID-19 by WHO and CDC

- COVID-19 caused by virus, spreads from person to person through respiratory droplets.
- Symptoms can range from mild (or no symptoms) to severe illness.
- Incubation period is 2-14 days.

Common Symptoms

- **Fever**
- **Cough**
- **Shortness of breath**

Prevention of Spread

- Wash/sanitize hands often
- Wear a face mask
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth
- Clean frequently contacted surfaces
- Social distancing
- Stay home if sick
- Stay informed on the latest developments about COVID-19.
