Rules & Instructions

Pre-primary I and Pre-primary II

Event 1: Story Telling.

Activity: Making Memories

- This is an individual event and a pre-recorded activity.
- The participant should choose a memorable family event and change it into a story.
- The story should include characters from the participant's family.
- The story should have a suitable name/title.
- A video recording of the participant's narration of the story should be shared with the host school 3 days prior to the event.
- The video should be a single recording with no edits.
- The duration of the video should not exceed 5 minutes.
- The recorded videos should be saved in MP4/MPEG/AVI/WMV/3GP format.
- The video files should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The recorded video clips should be shared with the host school on email.
- The email id will be shared by the host school after registration.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

- Creativity and Adherence to Theme (10)
- Continuity and Flow of the Story (10)
- Grammatical Accuracy and Linguistic Expression (10)
- Use of Voice Modulation and Gestures (10)
- Use of Props and Presentation (10)

Event 2: Vegetable Art

Activity: Artsy Craftsy

- This is a live event and a pair activity.
- One student and one parent should participate in this activity.
- The participants should make vegetable printing art on an A4 sheet.
- The parent should only support and printing should be done by student.
- The same parent should remain with the student till the completion of the activity.
- The teams can use vegetables and colours of their choice.
- The parent should ensure the safety of the student while doing the activity.
- The participants should login at the specified time.
- The login details will be shared 3 days prior to the event.
- The participants need to ensure strong bandwidth and stable network connectivity.
- Once the art work is ready, the participants should take 2/3 pictures of it and share it with the host school.

- The art work should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The link for uploading the pictures will be shared along with the login details.
- The pictures of the artwork should be clear.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

Grades I and II

Event 1: Flower Arrangement with Fruits

Activity: Fruity Bouquet

- This is a family event and a pre-recorded activity.
- The student should participate with a minimum of 2 family members.
- The team should use fruits and cut them into flowers, leaves, etc. and make the arrangement.
- A minimum of 4 fruits are to be used for making of the bouquet.
- The team should record a video of the major steps of making the arrangement.
- The video should end with the team's presentation of the arrangement.
- The presenter should connect the arrangement to some values existent in the family.
- The duration of the video should not exceed 5 minutes.
- The video should be recorded by the team and shared with the host school 3 days prior to the event.
- The recorded videos should be saved in MP4/MPEG/AVI/WMV/3GP format.
- The video files should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The recorded video clips should be shared with the host school on email.
- The email id will be shared by the host school after registration.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

Event 2: Framing Families.

Activity: Make a family photo frame

- This is a live event and an individual activity.
- The participants should login at the specified time and make their photo frames.
- The participants should make a frame for a family picture of their choice.
- The photograph size should be 6"x 8".
- The photo frame should have an appropriate caption describing the picture.
- The caption should be their own and not more than 10-12 words.
- The caption should be crisp, clear and catchy.
- The duration for this activity is 45 minutes.
- All required material should be kept ready before the start of the event.
- Participants should keep their cameras on throughout the competition.
- Once the frame is ready, the participants should take 2/3 pictures of it.
- The pictures of the frame should capture both the art work and the caption clearly.
- The pictures should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The login details will be shared 3 days prior to the event.
- The link for uploading the pictures will be shared along with the login details.
- The participants should take extra care while using sharp objects like scissors.
- The participants must be dressed as per the school norms.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

Grades III - V

Event 1: Meal Preparation

Activity: The Family Platter

- This is a family event and a pre-recorded activity.
- The student should participate with a minimum of 2 family members.
- The Platter should be a complete, balanced meal with a minimum of 6 dishes.
- The display should be neat and presentable.
- Care should be taken while using knives, electrical and gas equipments.
- The team should record a video of the major steps of the cooking process only, speak about the importance of a family meal, the dishes and their nutritional value.
- The entire video recording should not be more than 6 minutes.
- The video should be recorded by the team and shared with the host school 3 days prior to the event.
- The recorded videos will have to be saved in MP4/MPEG/AVI/WMV/3GP format.

- The video files should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The link for uploading the videos will be shared by the host school.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

Event 2: Comic Strip

Activity: Story Canvas

- This is a live event and an individual activity.
- The duration of this activity is 60mins.
- The comic strip should be based on any humorous incident in the family.
- The presentation should be in black only.
- The comic strip should flow from left to right with a maximum of 6 frames.
- The organisation of sketches and presentation should be neat and appealing.
- All the dialogues should be in English and befitting the norms of the school.
- All required materials should be kept ready before the start of the event.
- The login details will be shared 3 days prior to the event.
- The participants need to ensure strong bandwidth and stable network connectivity.
- The participants should keep their cameras on throughout the event.
- Once the comic strip is ready, the participants should take 2/3 pictures of it.
- The captured pictures of the comic strip should be clear and the text should be easily readable.
- The picture of the prepared strip should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The link for uploading the prepared strip will be shared along with the login details.
- The students should be ready to respond to the judge's query post review, if needed.
- The participants must be dressed as per the school norms.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

Grades VI - VIII

Event 1: Making Music

Activity: The Family Raga

- This is a live event and a team activity.
- Each team should have 3-5 family members including the student.
- The participants should choose any household implements to create music.
- The participants should compose and play their own music using utensils of their choice or they should choose a song and play the instrumental version of the song using utensils of their choice. Singing is not required.
- The teams should not use any other musical instruments along with.
- The login details will be shared 3 days prior to the event.
- The participants need to ensure strong bandwidth and stable network connectivity.
- The team should log in at the specified time and keep the camera on throughout their performance.
- Each group should begin with an introduction of the family members and the music/song they have chosen to play.
- The performance of each group should not exceed 5 minutes.
- The music and costume should be befitting the norms of the school.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

Event 2: Art Activity

Activity: Doodle-Shoodle

- This is an individual event and a pre-recorded activity.
- The participant should use the doodle style of drawing to depict a family celebration.
- The doodle should be bright and colourful.
- The doodle should use motifs from Indian folk art.
- The doodle activity should be shot and converted into a time-lapse video. (Further instructions given below.)
- The video should be recorded by the participant and shared with the host school 4 days prior to the event.
- The recorded videos should be saved in MP4/MPEG/AVI/WMV/3GP format.
- The video files should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The link for uploading the video will be shared by the host school after registration.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

How to make a time-lapse video?

- To make a time-lapse video the participant should focus the camera on his/her paper as the drawing is done. (The students should be visible intermittently)
- After the drawing is completed, the video can be added to any video editor.
- The speed of the video can be increased to convert to a time-lapse video.

Grades IX - XII

Event 1: Shark Tank

Activity: Product Pitch

- This is a team event with 3 or 4 students and a live presentation activity.
- The students should work on the theme, 'How can I improve the quality of life for my family?'
- The students should identify something that could make life better for them and their family.
- They should have a virtual model of their innovation (created beforehand) and present it to the judges.
- Their solution should be one or more of the following: Use of hardware (machine, device, installation, etc.), Use of software (app, program, website, etc.) or anything else (organization, policies, rules, educational campaign).
- The virtual model should help them tell the story of their innovation.
- The product idea should be innovative, original, creative and align with the theme
- All members on the team should speak during the presentation.
- The participants need to ensure strong bandwidth and stable network connectivity.
- The team should take not more than 7mins. for the presentation, followed by the judges questions.
- A synopsis of the innovation/model should be shared with the host school 2 days prior to the event.
- The link for uploading the synopsis will be shared along with the login details.
- The login details will be shared by the host school, 2 days prior to the event.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

Tips for your pitch:

- Keep it simple!
- Be clear about what you will accomplish with your project.
- Present as if your pitch is meant to inform, engage and market.



Event 2: Design an Advertisement

Activity: Product Melodrama

- This is a team event and a prerecorded activity.
- The team should have 3-4 members.
- The team should choose a product used in homes and design the advertisement.
- The presentation should not exceed 3mins.
- The teams could either have all the team members together or the individual parts may be stitched together.
- Background Music, Props, Voice over wherever required should be included in the presentation.
- The chosen product should be displayed effectively with family as the setting.
- Any deviation from the theme, use of obscene language, gestures and expressions is not permitted.
- Ideas which affect the sentiments of people should not be portrayed.
- The presentations can be humorous but should not be like mad ads.
- The team should find a place for all characters in the last frame, when the Ad ends.
- The video along with the script has to be shared with the host school 3 days prior to the competition.
- The recorded videos should be saved in MP4/MPEG/AVI/WMV/3GP format.
- The video files should be saved as <name of school>, <name of the participant>, <event name>.
- The link for uploading the video will be shared by the host school after registration.
- The judges decision is final and binding.

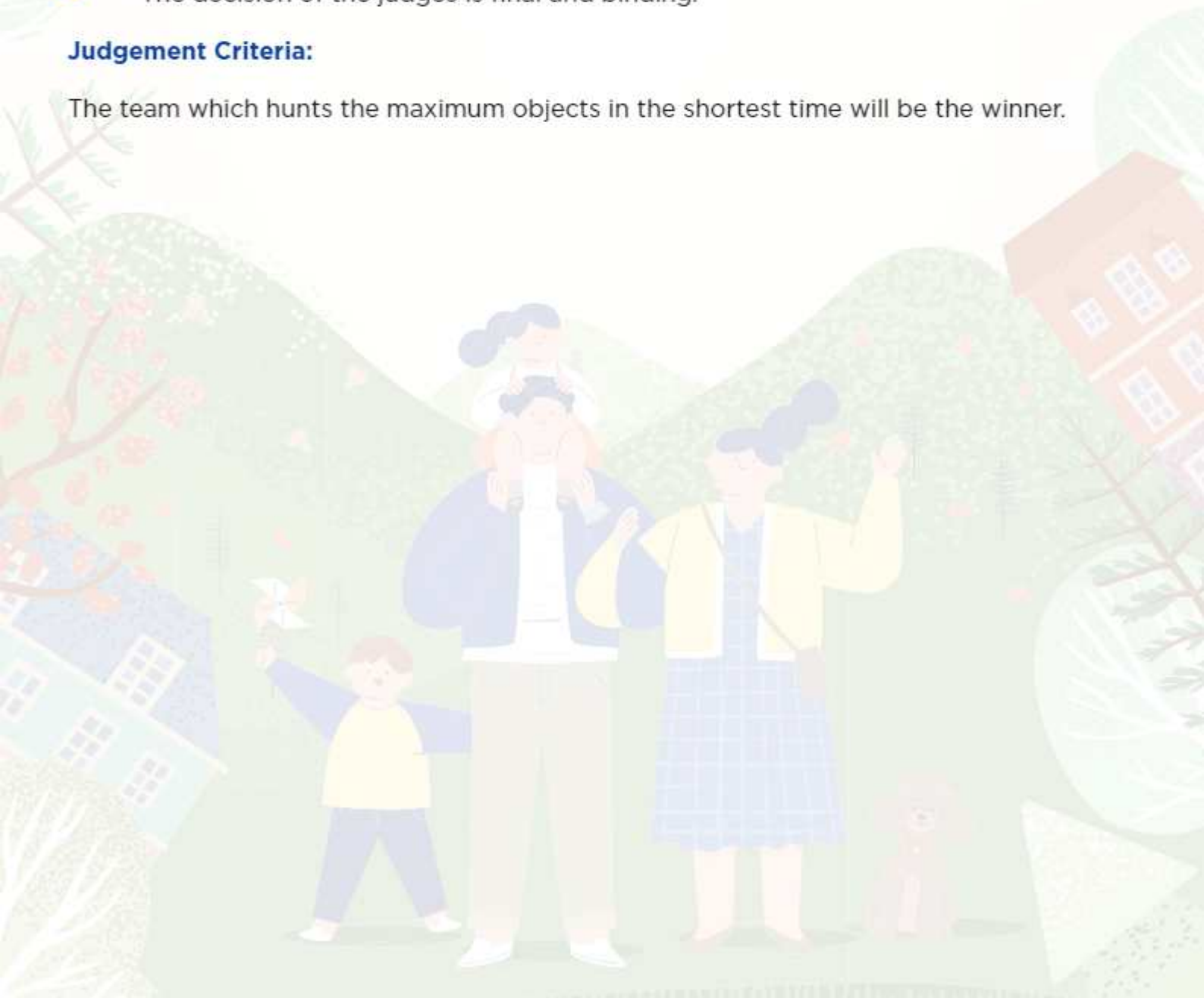
Event 1: Let's Look Around

Activity: Treasure Hunt

- This is a team event with 10 students participating from across levels.
- This is an event played at all 5 Levels-Grades (1, 2); (3, 4); (5-7), (8-10), (11, 12)
- 2 participants should form one team and there should be 5 teams in all, from each school.
- This is a live event conducted and monitored by the host school.
- The older student at each level should read the clue(card), decode and call out the objects to be hunted by the younger students.
- The younger students should listen carefully and get the objects from their home.
- The schools with no 11 and 12 grades, two teams of (9,10) should play the game.
- The team which finds the maximum correct objects in the shortest time is the winner.
- The groups should show the objects to the teacher in-charge who will check and confirm the same.
- The login details will be shared 3 days prior to the event.
- The decision of the judges is final and binding.

Judgement Criteria:

The team which hunts the maximum objects in the shortest time will be the winner.
