Dear Parents,

Greetings from T.M. Patel International School!!! As we begin a new academic year, we would like to remind you of the rules and regulations that are in place at our school. These rules are in place to ensure the safety and well-being of all students and staff members. Please take a moment to review the following guidelines:

- It is important that you attend all classes and arrive before 7:55 am. If the child is going to be absent kindly inform through parent application or by submit a hard copy of written application.
- Please adhere to the **SCHOOL UNIFORM POICY -**  
**Pre-Primary to Grade IV:**  
GIRLS: Navy blue pinafore and blue striped shirt with bloomers/shorts, School tie, Navy blue socks and black shoes (with Velcro).  
BOYS: Navy blue shorts and blue striped shirt with bloomers/shorts, School tie, Navy blue socks and black shoes (with Velcro).  
**Grade V to Grade XII:**  
GIRLS: Navy blue Skirt and blue striped shirt with bloomers/shorts, School tie, Navy blue socks and black shoes (with Velcro).  
BOYS: Navy blue shorts and blue striped shirt with bloomers/shorts, School tie, Navy blue socks and black shoes (with Velcro).  
**Sports Uniform: Grade 1 to12 - To be worn on WEDNESDAY AND SATURDAY.**  
**Pre-Primary – To be worn on THURSDAY.**  
House colour T-Shirts and half pant/Track pant.
- Nails to be pared and clean, Shoes and Socks must be clean and polished. Hair must be neatly combed with **hair oil and two ponies'** compulsory. For boys Hair cut should be simple and short.
- Parents those who have **opted out canteen**, Kindly note that you have to send the tiffin (lunch/ Breakfast) with the child only. As it disrupts the school's lunch schedule and can create confusion for the students. It is important for parents to plan ahead and ensure that their child had **packed lunch in the morning only**.
- Kindly **carry** your parent ID card compulsory if you are coming to school for any purpose.
- **Medical Policy:** This policy is in place to ensure the safety and well-being of all students on campus. If a student requires medication during school hours, parents **must provide written consent** via School diary, Written application or Parent Application and **the medication must be administered by the School Nurse**. This helps to prevent any potential misuse or allergic reactions that could occur if the medication is not properly supervised.
- **On Birthday**, kindly don't send anything beyond 5 Rs. (Cakes are not allowed during any birthday celebrations).
- **During Star of the Week**, parents need not to bring any gift items for the kids.
- Apart from parents, if any other person comes to pick the child, it is mandatory for parents to write us on **Feedback** with photo/id of person attached.
- Children bringing their own vehicle should have **at least learning licence** and it is compulsory in such cases to **wear Helmet**.
