Rules & Instructions

Group 1 Pre-primary 2 and Pre-primary 3

Event 1: Living Legends

- This is an individual event
- Each participant will dress up as a living legend who has represented India in the global world in the area of sports, science, art and culture, CEOs, entrepreneurs etc
- Each participant will be given 2 minutes to introduce themselves and talk about the achievement
- Participants are not permitted to use any audio or video recording
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Judgement Criteria:

- Choice of the legend (10)
- Creativity and aesthetics (10)
- Presentation (10)
- Confidence and clarity (10)
- Adherence to time (10)

Event 2: Piece by Piece

- This is a pair event
- Each pair should comprise one member of each grade
- The event comprises 2 rounds
- Each pair would be given a puzzle based on the theme
- The first 10 teams to solve the puzzle will qualify for the final round
- The pair that solves the puzzle first will be the winner

Note : This event will have two rounds only when the number of participating pairs are more than 10.



Rules & Instructions

Group 2 Grades : 1 and 2

Event 1: Share and Shine

- This is an individual event
- Each participant will bring a unique product or a picture of the product which is Made in India
- The products must be easy to carry and do not pose any safety hazards
- Each participant will be given 2 minutes to share and talk about the product
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Judgement Criteria:

- Uniqueness of the Product (10)
- Alignment to the Theme (10)
- Interesting Facts (10)
- Confidence and Clarity (10)
- Adherence to time (10)

Event 2: Sporty Steps

- This is a team event
- Each team will comprise a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 members with at least 1 member from each grade
- Any sport prop can be used. Ex - Racket, ball, hoop, skipping rope, bat
- Each team will be given 3 to 5 minutes to perform
- Each team should bring their own props
- Each team should get the song/ music in a pendrive and submit it before the event
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

- Dance Technique and Skill (10)
- Usage of the Prop (10)
- Aesthetics (10)

Rules & Instructions

Group 3 Grades : 3, 4 and 5

Event 1: Swift Sports Challenge

- This is an individual event
- Each participant will perform a set of sports related task
- One minute will be given to each sport related task
- Each participant will have to perform all the tasks
- All tasks will be scored separately
- The participant with the highest total will be the winner

The Tasks:

- Skipping
- Basketball Dribble
- Throw and Catch
- Badminton Bounce
- Hula Hoop Pass

Event 2: RAP Blitz

INDIA - THE RISING TITAN

- This is a team event
- Each team will comprise a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 members with at least 1 member from each grade
- Each team presents a RAP on the theme without any musical instrument
- Each team will be given 3 to 5 minutes
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Rules & Instructions

Group 4 Grades : 6, 7 and 8

Event 1: Chrono Canvas

- This is an individual event
- Each participant will create a poster based on the theme which will be given on the spot
- The poster should depict aspects of the past, present, and future of the given theme
- A3 size sheets will be provided by the host school
- The participants must bring their own stationery or any other material that they may require
- The participants will be given 1 hour
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Judgement Criteria:

- Creativity and Originality (10)
- Relevance to the Theme and Chronology (10)
- Design and Composition (10)
- Visual Impact (10)
- Colour harmony (10)

Event 2: Marketing Marvels

- This is a team event
- Each team will comprise a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 members with at least 1 member from each grade
- Each team will be given a product based on the theme
- The team needs to design a creative advertisement to market the product globally
- The participants must bring their own stationery or any other material that they may require
- The participants will be given 1 hour to prepare and 3 minutes to enact the advertisement
- The language and the gestures should be appropriate as per school norms.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Group 5 Grades : 9, 10, 11 and 12

Event 1: Giggle Gala

- This is an individual event
- Each participant presents a comedy set on the topic : Hindrances to India Shining
- Each participant will be given 5 minutes to present the comedy set
- Each participant can present the comedy set in English, Hindi or the regional language
- The comedy set may be satirical and intellectually stimulating, while still being humorous
- The comedy set should not target people's race, gender, religious affiliations or abilities
- The language should be suitable as per the school norms
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

Judgement Criteria:

- Creativity and Originality (10)
- Content and Language (10)
- Comic Timing (10)
- Technique and Style (10)
- Audience Engagement (10)

Event 2: Venture Adventure

- This is a team event
- Each team should comprise a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 members with at least 1 member from each grade.
- Each team must prepare a pitch based on the theme, and build a business plan that includes: Executive Summary, Problem Statement, Proposed Solution, Market Analysis, Implementation Plan and Social Impact.
- Each team will be given 10 minutes to present their plan
- Projects must be original and developed specifically for this competition
- A prototype or detailed proof of concept must be included
- The team must present a print out of the plan to the judges
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding

School Event All Grades

Event 1: The Great Escape

- This is a team event

- The first team to solve all the puzzles or challenges accurately in the correct order will be the winner of the event
